Our categories are the **Largest kite** flown, **Smallest kite** flown, **Best home-made kite** flown, **Prettiest kite** flown, **Highest kite**, **Most spectacular Crash** and **Best Kite flown by a Squadron Commander**. There will be a separate competition for 14 and younger for the **first kite up** after the starting signal for this competition.

There will be a group of eight judges, two from each above Squadron, and the judges' decisions are final.
